Phoenix Hall is a residence belonging to the University of Brighton. In the summer, St Giles students can stay here. It is a short 10-15 minute walk from St Giles Brighton.

The residence is split into flats containing 8 single en-suite rooms. All rooms have a single bed, desk, wardrobe and a separate shower and toilet. The shared kitchens are fully equipped with an electric cooker, refrigerator, two freezers, microwave, kettle, crockery and utensils. There is also a student lounge in each flat.

Students are responsible for tidying their own bedrooms and washing their dishes. You should also bring your own towels. Bed linen is provided and the lounges and kitchens are cleaned once a week.

There is a market, shops and supermarket within easy reach where you can buy food.

Each block has a separate door entry code and there is an intercom entry system for each flat. There is a telephone on the ground floor of each block. Rooms are available Saturday to Saturday and you can arrive between 3 and 9pm that day. The reception office is staffed 24 hours a day.

There is a communal laundry and cleaning items (vacuum cleaner, mop + bucket, brush and dustpan + brush) are available to borrow in the kitchen/lounge.

Phoenix Hall is a great experience for the more independent-minded person. You have privacy in your en-suite room but can mix with other students from around the world and from other language schools in the residence kitchen or lounge.
